Women also known as Shakthi and the power in them in achieving great heights was understood by the participants.












Two days' Workshop on Art of Living (08.12.2021 & 09.12.2021)

The visit made students understand the beauty of nature, the good environment we need to maintain to have a beautiful and peaceful life.




International Non-Violence Day & 152nd Birth Anniversary of Gandhi (01.10.2021)

Teachers Day Celebration (05.09.2021)


